GP had a pamper day and enjoyed having her hair cut and coloured. She is making huge strides in taking care of herself and her environment.








Charleen has now started visiting her local community hub.

Charleen thoroughly enjoyed her first involvement in her local community group with her two staff Malik and Jenny.




Charleen loved being involved with her neighbours and going around her local community. The mission was to collect data about local pollution in the area and how waste management could be better.
